

## Scope of application

## Collection and use of information

In access to the portal, various access data (e.g. IP address, date and time of the access, name of the file accessed

etc.) are stored. There are no person-related assessments. For statistical purposes, data are evaluated anonymously, e.g. in order to see how many people access the portal on one day. These data are treated with strict confidentiality and not forwarded outside the Interhome Group for commercial purposes or made accessible to other third parties, unless this is demanded by valid law and in particular by the responsible criminal prosecution authority.

As a result of your reservation or booking inquiry, Interhome AG additionally possesses various data on your person. This personal information is only used for purposes necessary to fulfil your accommodation arrangements. This in particular affects:

- Customer data (surname, first name, address)
- Booking data (start, end, object)
- Availability (telephone, e-mail)
- Payment information (credit card information - optional)
- Interests and wishes (holiday destinations, price category)

## Cookies

In the use of the portal, small files (so-called «cookies») are stored on the users' computers. These files are exclusively used for anonymous recording of numbers of visitors and recognition of recurring visitors for the purpose of personalisation.

## Data security

All your data are protected by a security-certified server. The «Secure Server Software» SSL (Secure Socket Layers) encrypts your personal data before they are sent to us. The data are only decrypted when they reach our server. Our network also possesses a firewall (security software) in order to protect our internal data against unauthorised access from the Internet.

## Accessing your personal information

Subject to the exceptions set out by law, you have the right to access any personal information we may hold on you. If we deny access, we will provide you with the reason for such denial. We reserve the right to charge a fee for reasonable costs of searching for and providing access to this information.
